SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION AND REQUIREMENTS

Revised 3-23-11

Students applying for a scholarship from The Transportation Club of Houston (TCH) and TCH members sponsoring students must meet all of the following requirements:

SPONSOR REQUIREMENT

All scholarship applicants must be sponsored by a TCH member in good standing. Members may only sponsor students that they know personally. Members can sponsor no more than two candidates including themselves. Members may not ask another member to sponsor an applicant for them.

Members of the Scholarship Committee cannot sponsor a candidate or secure a sponsor for a candidate. The Scholarship Committee will hold all scholarship application information confidential.

APPLICATION & TRANSCRIPT REQUIREMENT

Scholarship applicants will forward a completed TCH Scholarship Application with a certified copy of their most recent transcript attached to the address indicated on the application. Copies of any kind, of transcripts are not acceptable.

All applications, essays, and transcripts must be received no later than April 15, 2011.

By applying, applicants authorize TCH Scholarship Committee to verify all data on the scholarship application.

WRITTEN ESSAY REQUIREMENT

Applicants must submit the following items:

1. A written essay of the following:

“Describe a time in your life where you saw and opportunity for improvement and took the initiative to make a difference. How would you use that experience to better the transportation industry as we know it today?”

The essay must be between 500 and 750 words. It must be double spaced, and checked for grammar and punctuation.

2. A scholarship application form
3. A transcript from their University

INTERVIEW REQUIREMENT

Applicant must be available to the TCH Scholarship Committee for interview as needed.

THE TRANSPORTATION CLUB OF HOUSTON SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

SCHOLARSHIP TERM & LIMITATIONS

TCH scholarships may be awarded on an annual basis. The total amount of scholarship funds for distribution will be determined by recommendation of the Scholarship Committee to the Board of Governors.

One or more TCH scholarships may be awarded to students in transportation and related fields such as warehousing, supply chain logistics, and international business and logistics.

Students are eligible to participate in the scholarship program at the start of the second semester level of their freshman year. Students can participate for a maximum of four years and must apply each year that they wish to participate.

CRITERIA FOR FORMER SCHOLARSHIP WINNERS;

Before applying for a second, third and fourth scholarship, a candidate must demonstrate involvement in club activities.

Scholarship winners will be assigned a mentor by the Scholarship Committee to work with the student while they are in the program and after graduation. Continued participation in this program is a prerequisite for further eligibility.

Student participation at regular TCH programs or activities must also be demonstrated.
